



# Cookie Policy

## 1. About This Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Charity Tax Group (CTG) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website. It should be read alongside our Privacy Notice, which explains how we use personal data.

By using our website, you agree that we can place the cookies described below on your device, unless your browser settings block them.

## 2. What Cookies Are

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function, improve security, and provide information to website owners about how people use the site.

Cookies can be:

- **Essential** – required for the website to function
- **Analytics** – help us understand how visitors use the site
- **Functional** – remember your preferences
- **Marketing** – track browsing to show relevant content (CTG does not currently use these)

## 3. Cookies We Use

### a. Essential cookies

These are required for the website to work properly. They include:

- session cookies that keep you logged in
- security cookies that protect the site
- cookies that remember your cookie preferences

These cookies cannot be turned off.

### b. Analytics cookies

We use analytics tools to understand how visitors use our website, including:

- which pages are visited
- how long visitors stay
- how users navigate the site
- technical information such as browser type and IP address

This helps us improve the website and ensure it meets members' needs.

Analytics cookies are only set if you accept them through the cookie banner.

#### c. **Functional cookies**

These allow the website to remember choices you make, such as:

- login details (if you choose "remember me")
- display preferences

These improve your experience but are not strictly necessary.

#### d. **Marketing cookies**

CTG does not currently use marketing or advertising cookies.

If this changes, the cookie banner and this policy will be updated before any such cookies are set.

### **4. Third Party Cookies**

Some cookies are set by third-party providers that support our website, including:

- website hosting provider
- analytics provider
- embedded content (e.g., videos or maps, if used)

These providers may set their own cookies when their content loads.

### **5. How You Can Control Cookies**

You can manage cookies in several ways:

#### a. **Through our cookie banner**

You can accept or reject non-essential cookies when you first visit the site.

#### b. **Through your browser settings**

Most browsers allow you to:

- block all cookies

- block only third-party cookies
- delete cookies
- receive alerts before cookies are set

Blocking some cookies may affect how the website functions.
